


Main Point for the Series:

God loves us and wants to answer our prayers. Pray to Him.

Listen for Him. Read about Him (Bible). Spend time with His people.

Memory Verse:

1 John 5:14-15

This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we know that He hears us —whatever we ask— we know that we have what we asked of Him.

This Week's Passage:

Matthew 7:7-11 ESV

Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you. For everyone who asks receives, and the one who seeks finds, and to the one who knocks it will be opened. Or which one of you, if his son asks him for bread, will give him a stone? Or if he asks for a fish, will give him a serpent? If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask him!

Main Point for the Week:

We can't see God. But we believe in him. He doesn't speak aloud to us. And yet, we know he hears our prayers. We want to be close to him. We sense in our hearts that this is right and good.

Main Point for the Week (cont.):

In this passage, we are reminded of the openness of God. God wants us to come to Him. He wants us to pray to Him about all of our needs, seek His will in all that we do, and knock on the doors of Heaven so that they can be opened to us. God wants a deep personal relationship with each of us. Jesus has opened the way for that relationship by paying for our sins on the cross. He now hears our prayers based on the righteous standing of Jesus, so in faith we can pray with great confidence.

Family Discussion Questions:

As a family, discuss these questions throughout the week.

- What do we call good gifts that come from God? We call them blessings.
- 2. Will God answer us, if we ask Him for something? Yes.
- 3. How can we seek God? We seek God by reading the Bible and attending church, where we can learn more about Him.
- 4. What is the very best gift that God has given us? God gave us the gift of Salvation, which means that we can be saved from our sins and spend eternity in Heaven.

How should we treat others? We should treat others in the way that we want to be treated.

Family Application Activity:

Family Prayer Jar

Needed Materials:

Provided in your pack-Prayer Jar Kit

<u>Prep</u>: Assemble the Prayer Jar with the peel and stick decorations.

Instructions:

- On the round pieces of foam, write the names of people your family will pray for during the 21 Days of Prayer.
- Place the names in the prayer jar.
- · If desired, cut more shapes from construction
- paper or card stock and add more names to the jar.

At some point each day, family members will select a name from the jar to pray for. This can be in the morning, at lunch, dinner time, or at bedtime or all the time). Pray as a family, and pray individually for the names in the jar.
