# WEEK 1

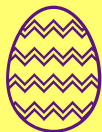
## Jesus the MIRACLE WORKER



**Jesus Raises a Girl: Mark 5:35-43**  
**Jesus Feeds 5,000: Matthew 14:13-21**  
**Jesus Walks on Water: Matthew 14:22-33**



**Pray and thank God for Jesus, the Miracle Worker. Praise God for His power and might in your life.**



**Open the yellow egg and find a fish inside. The fish reminds us of Jesus' miracle by feeding 5,000 people. Talk about Jesus' power, and how He can do anything.**



**Great work finishing week 1! As a family, check off the week 1 box on the map.**

# WEEK 2

## Jesus the TEACHER



**The Prodigal Son: Luke 15:11-32**  
**The Rich Young Ruler: Mark 10:17-27**  
**The Good Samaritan: Luke 10:25-37**



**Pray and thank God for Jesus, the Teacher. Ask Him to help you learn and grow from His teachings and to apply them to your daily life.**



**Open the pink egg and find a coin inside. The coin reminds us of the parable Jesus told about a rich young ruler. A parable is a story Jesus would tell to teach His followers something. Talk about how Jesus taught us how to live through parables.**



**Great work finishing week 2! As a family, check off the week 2 box on the map.**

# WEEK 3

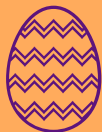
## Jesus the FRIEND



**Jesus and Zacchaeus: Luke 19:1-10**  
**Jesus and Lazarus: John 11:1-44**  
**Jesus and The Disciples: John 13:1-17**



**Pray and thank God for Jesus, the Friend. Ask Him to help you be a good friend to everyone around you, so that they see Jesus in you.**



**Open the orange egg and find a tree inside. The coin reminds us Zacchaeus and how Jesus was a friend to him. Talk about how Jesus' example of being a good friend to everyone is one we should follow.**



**Great work finishing week 3! As a family, check off the week 3 box on the map.**

# WEEK 4

## Jesus the RESCUER



**The Triumphal Entry: Luke 19:28-40**  
**Jesus' Last Supper and Arrest: Mark 14:22-50**  
**Jesus' Crucifixion and Burial: Mark 15:1-47**  
(To be read on Good Friday.)



**Pray and thank God for Jesus, the Teacher. Ask Him to help you learn and grow from His teachings and to apply them to your daily life.**



**Open the blue egg and find a cross. The cross reminds us that Jesus died in our place. Talk about how Jesus gave His life to defeat sin and death so we didn't have to. On Good Friday, reflect on the sacrifice Jesus made to rescue us, and prepare your heart for a celebration on Easter morning.**



**Great work finishing week 4! As a family, check off the week 4 box on the map.**

# EASTER

# He is RISEN



**The Resurrection:  
Luke 24:1-12**



**Pray and thank God for fulfilling His  
Great Rescue Plan for us through  
Jesus.**



**Open the green egg to find it empty. The  
empty egg reminds us of the empty tomb  
and that Jesus has victory over sin and  
death. Talk about what the life, death, and  
resurrection of Jesus means for us.**



**Great work discovering Easter! As a family,  
go back through each egg and review  
what you have learned about Jesus.**
