Main Point for the Series:

The Good News of Jesus changes everything, including you! Let your light shine!

This Week's Passage:

Philippians 3:17-21

Brothers and sisters, join together in following my example. You have us as a model. So pay close attention to those who live as we do. I have told you these things many times before. Now I tell you again with tears in my eyes. Many people live like enemies of the cross of Christ. The only thing they have coming to them in death. Their stomach is their god. They brag about what they should be ashamed of. They think only about earthly things. But we are citizens of heaven. And we can hardly wait for a Savior from there. He is the Lord Jesus Christ. He has the power to bring everything under His control. By His power He will change our earthly bodies. They will become like His glorious body.

Memory Verse:

Philippians 1:6

Being confident of this, that He who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion until the day of Christ Jesus.

Main Point for the Week:

With God's help, I will try to follow others who are following Jesus. I will try to be an example for other people to follow also.

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Family Discussion Questions:

As a family, discuss these questions throughout the week.

- 1. Parents, when you were a child, who did you look up to and try to imitate? Kids, who do you look up to and try to follow their example?
- 2. Do you still look up to that person today? Why or why not?
- 3. Who do you look up to as an example living as a follower of Jesus? In what ways do you want to follow their example?
- 4. How can we follow the example of Jesus?
- 5. Who is the person you most want to see in heaven?
- 6. How can you help your friends and family prepare for heaven?

Family Application Activities:

Beach Ball Memory Challenge

You will need: a beach ball, the memory verse, and a large space to play.

Memory Verse: Philippians 1:6

Grade Schoolers: "And I am sure of this, that He who began a good work in you

will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ."

Preschoolers: "He who began a good work in you will complete it."

Instructions:

Blow up the beach ball and head outside. Have your family stand in a circle. Begin to hit the beach ball in the air. Each time someone hits it up they must say one word of the memory verse. Continue passing and saying the verse in order. If the ball drops and hits the ground, you must start the verse over. To adapt for preschoolers, toss the ball back and forth and say the words together. Continue to play until you complete the verse and can say it by memory.

Follow Up:

Continue to practice reciting the verse together throughout the week, and talk about the importance of hiding God's Word in your heart.




