Main Point for the Series:

In many areas, our culture is almost unrecognizable compared to a generation ago. But no matter how desperate things may be, there is hope. Because of Someone greater, we must commit to something greater.

Memory Verse:

1 John 4:4

Little children, you are from God and have overcome them, for He who is in you, is greater than he who is in the world.

This Week's Passage:

Mark 14:3-9 (NirV)

Jesus was in Bethany. He was at the table in the home of Simon, who had a skin disease. A woman came with a special sealed jar. It contained very expensive perfume made out of pure nard. She broke the jar open and poured the perfume on Jesus' head.

Some of the people there became angry. They said to one another, "Why waste this perfume? It could have been sold for more than a year's pay. The money could have been given to poor people." So they found fault with the woman.

"Leave her alone," Jesus said. "Why are you bothering her? She has done a beautiful thing to me. You will always have poor people with you. You can help them any time you want to. But you will not always have me. She did what she could. She poured perfume on my body to prepare me to be buried. What I'm about to tell you is true. What she has done will be told anywhere the good news is preached all over the world. It will be told in memory of her.

Main Point for the Week:

Passion must be greater than complacency. Jesus deserves our best.

Jesus has given us the most wonderful gift imaginable—the gift of everlasting life. It is free, but it was a very costly gift. It cost Jesus His life.

What can we give to Jesus to show our love for Him? I don't think He wants a diamond ring, a stuffed animal, a doll, or an autographed baseball. I think He wants us to give Him our very best. He wants us to give Him our life!

Jesus gave His life to show His love for us. May we also give our lives in service to Him as an expression of our love.

7. Do you think the woman really loved Jesus? How?
8. Mary spared no expense to show her love for Jesus. She poured out an expensive jar of perfume to honor Him. How can we honor Jesus with our lives, like Mary did?



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
