Main Point for the Series:

In many areas, our culture is almost unrecognizable compared to a generation ago. But no matter how desperate things may be, there is hope. Because of Someone greater, we must commit to something greater.

Memory Verse:

1 John 4:4

Little children, you are from God and have overcome them, for He who is in you, is greater than he who is in the world.

This Week's Passage:

Luke 6:27-36

But I say to you who hear, Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who abuse you. To one who strikes you on the cheek, offer the other also, and from one who takes away your cloak do not withhold your tunic either. Give them back. And as you wish that others would do to you, do so to them. If you love those who love you, what benefit is that to you? For even sinners love those who love them. And if you do good to those who do good to you, what benefit is that to you? For even sinners do the same. And if you lend to those from whom you expect to receive, what credit is that to you? Even sinners lend to sinners, to get back the same amount. But love your enemies, and do good, and lend, expecting nothing in return, and your reward will be great, and you will be sons of the Most High, for He is kind to the ungrateful and the evil. Be merciful, even as your Father is merciful.

Main Point for the Week:

Love must be greater than hate. Because Jesus first loved us so much, we must love those who do not love us back.

Family Discussion:

As a family, discuss these questions throughout the week.

1. What did Jesus mean when he said, "Do to others as you would have them do to you?"
2. Why should you love your enemies?
3. Who should we give to?
4. Why do you think we should show mercy to others?

Family Application Activity:

Give Thanks Journal

Needed Materials:

Prayer Journal craft kit, crayons or markers



Use the instructions in the craft kit to help your child construct their journal. Once constructed, read 1 John 4:4.

"Little children, you are from God and have overcome them, for He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world."

Younger Kids: Talk about some things that are really BIG. (oceans, towers, giants) Help them draw a picture of the BIG things in the journal. Talk about how God is bigger than everything! Say a prayer to thank God for being greater.

Older Kids: On each page of the Journal, have your kids write something God is greater than. It could be a fear or an experience; something that's going on in the world. Then, help them write or draw a picture describing it.

EX: God > Sickness: Showing God's Love > Hate; God's Kingdom > The World; Faith in God > Fear

Pray and give thanks to God for being greater.
